The Consulate General of Greece in Toronto, acting in accordance with the provisions set forth in Law 4412/2016, as subsequently amended, hereby announces its intention to enter into a contract for the provision of professional moving and relocation services for the Consulate General, located at 1075 Bay Street, Suite 600, Toronto, ON, M5S 2B1, Canada, for a total budget of \$35,290.52 CAD, inclusive of all applicable taxes

Services Requested:

1. Commercial Moving Services with items Packed at 1075 Bay St, Toronto Ontario and delivery to 2 Bloor St E, Toronto ON.
2. Packing of breakable items and prep. Packing glass credenza in board room, glass desk tops, art work, kitchen dishes and statues.
3. Installers to start dismantle of shelves in the storage room, boardroom table and furniture in the office suites.
4. Valuation Commercial \$75,000 - \$300 Deductible Includes \$75,000.00 of cargo coverage. The cost of enhance cargo protection beyond \$75,000.00 is based on \$4.00 per \$1,000.00 of additional declared value & is to be identified above in the protection premium.
5. AMJ to set up a ship and receive meaning there will be a crew on each side and the trucks going back and forth.
6. Moving 11 office suites, 1 boardroom, large storage room, 500 banker boxes, kitchen, waiting area, copy area (7 to 8 loads total)
