Access to the fairgrounds

The METROPOLITAN EXPO Event Centre is located at Athens International Airport “Eleftherios Venizelos” in Spata, Attica, just 2 km after the Airport buildings and a few minutes from the station of the Metro and Suburban Railway.

Access to the METROPOLITAN EXPO is more than easy through a large number of transportation options, from the Metro and bus to the plane and car.

Through the most modern and safe roads, METROPOLITAN EXPO is just:

- 2 minutes distance from the Airport
- 35 minutes distance from downtown Athens
- 15 minutes distance from the [National](#) Road Athens / Thessaloniki
- 30 minutes distance from the National Road Athens / Patras - Tripoli

It is also easily accessible to visitors from outside the region of Attica via the connection of the [National](#) Highway and Attiki Odos.

In detail:

- **By road**

Via Attiki Odos Expressway, 2 km after all the Airport facilities (Arrivals, Departures, Hotel, Metro station etc.), and with practical parking lots.

- **By air**

METROPOLITAN EXPO is a short distance from the Athens International Airport “Eleftherios Venizelos”. Shuttle buses service is provided for the distance between the Athens International Airport and the exhibition centre.

- **By Public Transport**

Airport stop, line 3 – Aigaleo / Monastiraki / Doukissis Plakentias / Airport

Suburban Railway

Airport stop, line Neratziotissa / Doukissis Plakentias / Airport

Buses

Connection of the exhibition center with public stations

All public transport stations (Metro-suburban railway OASA and KTEL Buses and Airport) are only 5 minutes away from the METROPOLITAN EXPO.

Shuttle bus service

Shuttle bus service is provided every 30' minutes for the distance between the Athens International Airport and the exhibition centre. Shuttle buses are parked outside gate 2 of Arrivals with the especially mark "Exhibition Centre".
