

### **Procedure once in Greece**

Within three months from their arrival in Greece, Canadian citizens need to apply for a residence permit, submitting the following documents, translated in greek where needed/indicated:

- application form
  - four (4) recent passport sized colour photos as well as in digital form (CD)
  - proof of payment of applicable fees (e-paravolo):
    - a) application fee 100 euros
    - b) fee for the printing of the e-card 16 euros
- [the fees under a) & b) have to be paid, prior to the application's submission, at any major bank]
- photocopy of all pages of the current Canadian passport, containing the national visa which is specifically granted for the purpose of this Agreement
  - certificate of full health care insurance covering all risks as per subparagraph (i) of article 3 of the Agreement
  - proof of a contract from an employer in Greece for a period of up to twelve (12) months. In the contract reference has to be made that the purpose of the employment is to gain work experience in support of their career development [for Canadian citizens falling under Article 2(a)],

**or**

- proof of registration as a student at a post-secondary or a higher education institution in Canada and proof of a pre-arranged contract for practical training/internship, from an employer in Greece, related to their field of study, in order to fulfill part of their academic curriculum [for Canadian citizens falling under Article 2(b)],

**or**

- written statement that the intention is to travel and to holiday in Greece and to obtain temporary employment in order to supplement existing financial resources [for Canadian citizens falling under Article 2(c) and proof of sufficient financial resources amounting to 600 Euros per month for a period of 3 months (1.800 euros in total). This document is only required in cases there is no temporary work contract at the time of application]

- An application package consists of two (2) sets of documents
