NORCAP is the Norwegian Refugee Council's expert deployment capacity. We aim to improve international and local capacity to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from crises. We do this by bringing together actors and deploying experts to the UN and to national, regional and international organizations and institutions

In Greece NORCAP has deployed more than 40 experts to improve protection and assistance. The experts have been instrumental in all parts of the response, from providing shelter and safety for the arriving refugees and migrants to identifying gaps in services and establishing procedures and structures to systematize the response.

The project aims to enhance the reception of the refugees and migrants by deploying NORCAP experts on reception to existing Reception and Identification Centres (RICs) in Greece, as well as to the RIS Headquarters (Central Service) in Athens. The NORCAP deployees will work in different teams, with national and international humanitarian actors, on a local and national level in the response.

The experts will be operational and respond to existing and emerging needs within their area of responsibility while contributing to capacity building of various stakeholders. The potential positions will have a focus on exchanging best practice and consolidating procedures between partners.
