The terms and conditions of the contest are defined as follows:

The contestants submit one project each. The size of the work should be two-dimensional and should not exceed 21 x 29.7 cm (A4) with free use of materials and style (painting, collage, photography, electronic painting, etc.)

The works must be sent in scanned form or photo (as an attached file) to the email address of the Consulate General of Greece in Johannesburg grgencon.jhb@mfa.gr until December, 16th.

Participation in the contest bears no financial burden participants have no claim whatsoever from the Consulate General regarding the copyright-intellectual property of the works they will submit.

The deadline for submission of projects is set from November 20 to December 16, 2020.

The jury of the contest has five members.

The committee selects three of the projects, which are awarded with a monetary coupon, donation of AJP. A commemorative diploma will be sent to all participants. The works of the contest will be presented online on the Facebook page of the Hellenic Federation of South Africa. The announcement of the contest is published in every medium and mainly electronically through the page of the Hellenic Federation and the social media, but also of the Greek radio station.

The main purpose of the contest is to help the educational process, regarding the historical event of the Greek Revolution of 1821, but also to cultivate and raise awareness of the ideals of freedom and democracy through an original creative process. Teachers of Greek Language Courses (TEΓ) help students to be inspired through the teaching of Greek history in order to express themselves, using their artistic skills.

The contest is addressed to all Greek students or not, aged 5-18, living in South Africa.
